This was the first multi-disciplinary clinic that I worked in, seeing both private and NHS patients through G.P fund-holding.

1996- : Hampton Court Health Clinic

In 1996 I established my first practice in which I still work from to this day.

1998- 2010 : The British School of Osteopathy

I have worked here since January 1998 teaching osteopathic technique to all four year groups as well as the mixed mode pathway. I have also led the third year rehab. technique classes, which included lesson planning and delivery to a set curriculum as well as continue to be involved with the third year OSPE process.

In 2005 I developed and currently deliver the course on 'Child Development' to the second year.

From 2002-2008 I was a clinic tutor, organising technique tutorials and attempting to encourage accurate technical delivery as taught by the POS team as well as suitable operator posture.
